

Rosa's French Greetings Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French greetings, introductions, and polite phrases appropriate for Year 5.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot has provided a word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a school in Lyon. She needs to greet her new friends, ask how they are feeling, and say goodbye politely at the end of the day.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Comment ça va? · Ça va bien · Enchanté · Au revoir · À bientôt · S'il vous plaît · Merci

1. Rosa meets a new friend in the morning. Write two different ways she could say 'hello' in French. (2 marks)

2. Rosa wants to ask her friend how they are feeling today. Write the French question she should use. (2 marks)

3. If a friend tells Rosa 'Ça va bien', what does this mean in English? (2 marks)

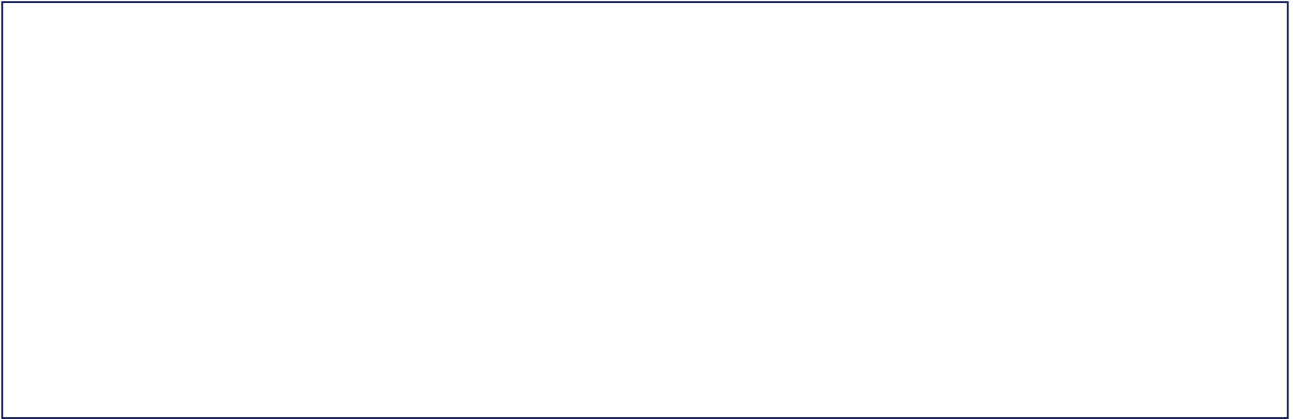
4. Rosa is introduced to a new group of friends. What word should she use to say 'nice to meet you'? (2 marks)

5. Explain the difference between saying 'Au revoir' and 'À bientôt'. When would you use each one? (4 marks)

6. Imagine you are meeting a new classmate for the first time. Write a short dialogue (at least 4 lines) in French where you greet them, ask how they are, and say goodbye. Include the English translation for each line. (8 marks)

7. Why is it important to use polite phrases like 'S'il vous plaît' and 'Merci' when speaking to others in French? (5 marks)
