

Rosa's French Number Party

Learning objective: To identify and understand French numbers from 1 to 20 in a simple context.

Read the story below carefully. Look at the word bank if you get stuck. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Rosa the parrot is having a small party in the rainforest. She is very excited. She has sent out invitations to all her friends. Rosa counts the snacks on the table. She has un bowl of fruit, deux plates of nuts, and trois jugs of cool water. Her friends arrive one by one. First, four monkeys arrive. Rosa says, 'Quatre monkeys!' Then, five birds land in the trees. Rosa smiles and says, 'Cinq birds!' Soon, there are many animals. Rosa counts them all. She is happy because she has exactly vingt guests at her party. She loves using her numbers. It makes sharing the snacks much easier. Rosa hands out the treats. Everyone is happy to be at the party. Rosa sings a song about numbers to thank them for coming. They dance until the sun goes down. It is the best party ever.

4. How does Rosa feel about having her friends at the party? Use the sentence starter: Rosa feels... (2 marks)

5. Do you think counting is an important skill at a party? Why? Use the sentence starter: I think counting is... (2 marks)
