Learning objective: To recall and apply French numbers from 1 to 20 accurately and understand their application in simple context.

Join Rosa the parrot for a quick French challenge! Read each question carefully. For multiple choice, select the correct letter. For True/False, write your answer clearly. Good luck, or as Rosa says, 'Bonne chance!'

Answer Key: 1) C (quinze), 2) True, 3) 12, 4) B (huit), 5) False (dix-neuf is 19), 6) 20, 7) A (sept), 8) 14, 9) True, 10) C (trois). Greater Depth Reasoning: When adding numbers like 5 + 6 (cinq + six), the answer is 11 (onze).

4. Which of these is the correct spelling for 8? A) sept, B) huit*, C) neuf, D) dix (1 mark)

5. True or False: The French word 'dix-huit' represents the number 19. (1 mark)

6. What is the English translation of the word 'vingt'? (1 mark)

7. How do you say 7 in French? A) sept*, B) six, C) quatre, D) cinq (1 mark)

8. Write the number that follows 'treize' (13) in French. (1 mark)

9. True or False: 'Un' is the French word for 1. (1 mark)

10. Which word means 3? A) deux, B) quatre, C) trois*, D) un (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a basket containing 'quinze' (15) apples and label the basket with the word 'quinze'.



Extension challenge: 1. Explain why knowing numbers 1-10 is essential for learning higher numbers in French. 2. Compare the structure of the words 'dix-sept' (17) and 'dix-huit' (18); what pattern do you notice? 3. Justify your answer: If you were shopping and an item cost 'dix livres' (£10) and another cost 'neuf livres' (£9), how much would they cost together in French? 4. What might happen if you confused 'seize' (16) with 'sept' (7) when telling someone your age? 5. Create a simple maths equation using only French number words (e.g., 'deux plus deux font quatre'). 6. If you were counting backwards from 20 to 1, which number would you find most difficult to spell and why?
