

Rosa's French Number Track

Learning objective: To learn and use numbers 1-20 in French.

Rosa the parrot is counting her favourite shiny pebbles. Look at the French number words below. Use the word bank to help you complete the tasks. Write your answers clearly on the lines.

Bonjour! I am Rosa. I love to count my pebbles in French. Let's count together: un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix. Can you help me finish my counting games?

Word bank: un (1) · deux (2) · trois (3) · quatre (4) · cinq (5) · six (6) · sept (7) · huit (8) · neuf (9) · dix (10)

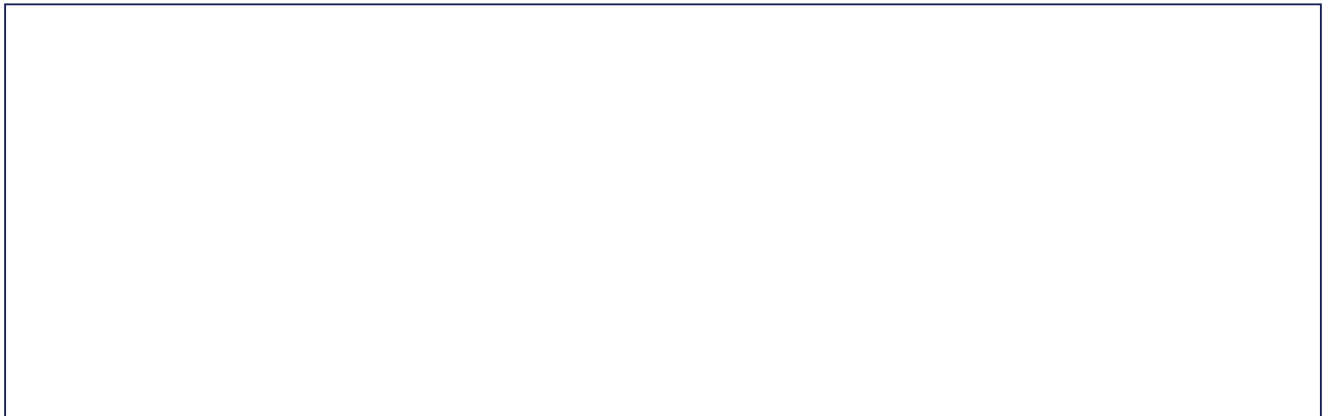
1. Rosa has 3 blue pebbles. How do you write '3' in French? (1 mark)

2. Rosa finds 5 red pebbles. How do you write '5' in French? (1 mark)

3. Fill in the missing number: un, deux, _____, quatre. (1 mark)

4. If Rosa has 10 pebbles and finds 0 more, she still has 10. Write '10' in French. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of 4 green pebbles next to the word 'quatre'.



Extension challenge: Try to write the French number for 6 and 7 in your exercise book.
