

Rosa's Review: My Likes and Dislikes

Learning objective: To express personal opinions in French using 'J'aime', 'J'adore', 'Je n'aime pas', and 'Je déteste' while justifying choices with reasons.

Join Rosa the parrot in her language garden! Use this review template to share your opinions on different school subjects, hobbies, or foods. Fill in the French phrase, the noun you are describing, and a reason in English or French. Remember to use your best handwriting!

Word bank: J'adore (I love) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · Je déteste (I hate) · parce que c'est (because it is) · amusant (fun) · ennuyeux (boring) · difficile (difficult) · facile (easy) · délicieux (delicious)

1. Choose a school subject. Write a sentence stating your opinion and justify why you feel this way. (Example: J'aime les maths parce que c'est amusant.) (2 marks)

2. Choose a food item. Use a negative opinion phrase (Je n'aime pas / Je déteste) and explain your reasoning. (2 marks)

3. Compare your two opinions. Explain why it is important to express our likes and dislikes politely. (3 marks)

4. Justify your answer: If you were to teach a friend a new French opinion phrase, which would be the most useful and why? (3 marks)

5. What might happen if we only ever used the phrase 'J'adore' for everything? How does using a variety of phrases improve your communication? (3 marks)

6. Creative Extension: Imagine Rosa the parrot is visiting a French café. Write a short dialogue (3-4 lines) where she orders something she loves and explains why it is delicious. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Challenge: Research three new French adjectives to describe your preferences. Can you write a paragraph using these new words alongside your opinion phrases?
