

Rosa's Opinion Picnic: French Preferences

Learning objective: To use and understand a range of French opinion phrases to express likes and dislikes regarding food and activities.

Rosa the parrot is packing a picnic basket for her friends! Help her organise the items based on their opinions. Look at the speech bubbles below, then match the correct opinion phrase to the food or activity based on the symbols provided. Use the word bank to complete the sentences.
