

Rosa's School Bag Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and write French vocabulary for common school items.

Rosa the parrot is packing her school bag. Look at the list of French words below. Match each French word to the correct English item by writing the number in the box. Use the word bank to help you spell the words correctly.

Word bank: un crayon (pencil) · un stylo (pen) · un livre (book) · une règle (ruler) · une gomme (rubber)

1. 1. un crayon: This is for writing. Draw a line to the word and write the English meaning here:

2. 2. un livre: Rosa loves reading these. Write the English word here:

3. 3. une gomme: This is used to fix mistakes. Write the English word here:
