

Rosa's French Shopping Trip: Assessment

Learning objective: To identify French vocabulary for common items and currency, and to use simple phrases to ask for prices and items in a shop.

Hello! I am Rosa. I love shopping at the French market. Look at the questions below. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly on the lines.

Rosa is at the market. She wants to buy a snack. She sees bread, red apples, and bars of chocolate. She says 'Bonjour' to the shopkeeper and asks how much things cost.

Word bank: le pain (bread) · une pomme (an apple) · le chocolat (chocolate) · Combien ça coûte? (How much does it cost?) · S'il vous plaît (Please) · Merci (Thank you) · livres (pounds) · centimes (pence)

1. Rosa wants to buy bread. Look at the word bank. Write the French word for bread. (2 marks)

2. Rosa wants to ask the price of the chocolate. What is the French phrase for 'How much does it cost?' (2 marks)

3. The apple costs £1.50. Write this in French using the words for pounds and pence. (4 marks)

4. Complete this sentence: 'Un pain, _____.' (Use the word bank for 'please'). (2 marks)

5. Rosa buys a chocolate bar for £2.00. Write a short sentence in French to thank the shopkeeper. (3 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Imagine you are at the shop with Rosa. Write 3 sentences in French about what you are buying and how much it costs. Use the word bank to help you. (12 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot standing in front of a market stall with an apple, bread, and chocolate on it.
