

Rosa's French Market Trip

Learning objective: To learn how to ask for items and say the price in French.

Read the story about Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Start your sentences with the prompts provided.

Rosa the parrot goes to the French market. She sees a stall with fruit and treats. The shopkeeper says, 'Bonjour!' Rosa wants a red apple. She says, 'Je voudrais une pomme.' The shopkeeper says, 'C'est deux livres.' Next, Rosa sees a yummy cake. She says, 'Je voudrais un gâteau.' The shopkeeper says, 'C'est cinq livres.'

Word bank: Je voudrais... (I would like...) · C'est... (It is...) · une pomme (an apple) · un gâteau (a cake) · deux livres (two pounds) · cinq livres (five pounds)

1. Rosa wants an apple. How does she ask for it in French? (2 marks)

2. How much is the apple? (Write the price in French). (2 marks)

3. Rosa wants a cake. How does she ask for it? (2 marks)

4. How much is the cake? (Write the price in French). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot at the market. Draw the apple and the cake next to her. Label them 'une pomme' and 'un gâteau'.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are at the market. What would you like to buy? Write a sentence in French starting with 'Je voudrais...' and guess how much it costs in pounds!
