

Rosa the Parrot's French Time Challenge

Learning objective: To tell the time in French using o'clock and half-past, and to understand simple time-based phrases.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the French words correctly. Rosa the Parrot is here to help you!

Rosa the parrot loves to fly at different times of the day. She checks her clock to make sure she is on time for her lessons. Look at the clocks below and help Rosa write the correct time in French.

Word bank: Il est · une heure · deux heures · trois heures · quatre heures · et demie · Quelle heure est-il ? · Il est midi.

1. Rosa asks: 'Quelle heure est-il?' Write the French phrase for 'It is one o'clock.' (2 marks)

2. It is 3:00. How do you say this in French? Use the sentence starter: Il est... (2 marks)

3. The clock shows 2:30. How do you write 'It is half-past two' in French? (3 marks)

4. Rosa says: 'Il est midi.' What time is she talking about in English? (3 marks)

5. Rosa has a busy day! Write a short timetable for her in French using simple sentences. For example: 'Il est quatre heures.' (You may use the word bank to help you). (5 marks)
