6. 6. True or False: 'Quatre heures' means 3 o'clock. (1 mark)

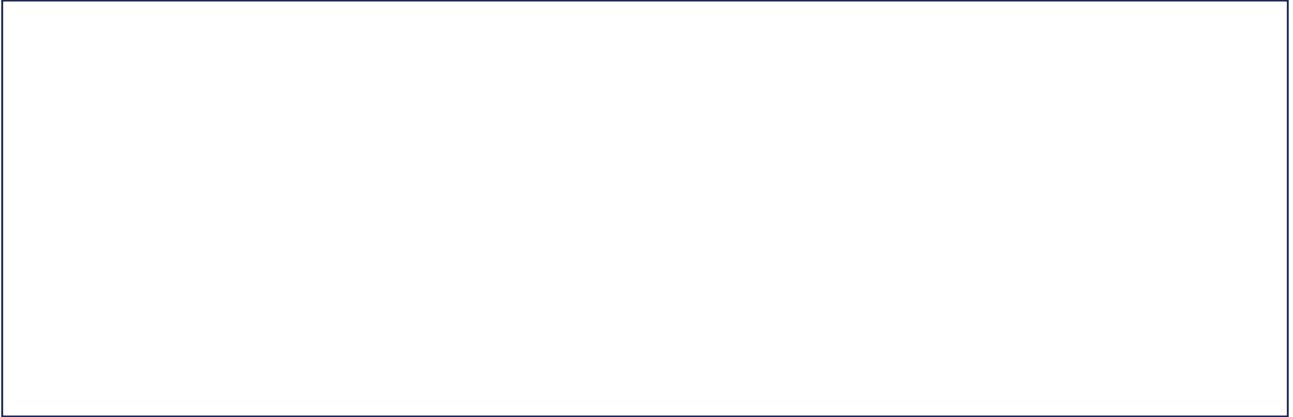
7. 7. Which phrase means 3 o'clock? A) une heure B) trois heures* C) deux heures (1 mark)
