

Rosa's Transport Adventure: French Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for different modes of transport within a creative context.

Help Rosa the parrot design her travel map! Use the word bank to label your drawings as you complete the scene.

Draw: Create a bustling travel scene on a large sheet of paper. Use a landscape orientation. Include a variety of terrains: a flat plain for the train tracks and road, a blue river cutting through the middle, and a bright sky with fluffy clouds. Sketch the transport items clearly so there is space to write the French labels next to them. Use vibrant colours for each vehicle.



Label words: le train · la voiture · le vélo · le bateau · l'avion · le bus

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a train track across the bottom of your page and sketch a train. Label it using the correct word from the bank.
2. Step 2: Draw a winding road above the tracks with a car driving on it. Label the car in French.
3. Step 3: Draw a river in the corner with a boat on the water. Label the boat in French.
4. Step 4: Draw a blue sky and add an aeroplane flying above the clouds. Label the plane in French.

5. Explain why you chose to place the 'avion' at the top of your drawing rather than the bottom. Justify your layout choices.
6. Compare and contrast 'le vélo' and 'la voiture'. What might happen if you tried to travel across the ocean using only these two modes of transport?
