

Year 5 French: Verbs and Tenses Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of present tense verb conjugations, infinitive forms, and the use of simple future structures in French.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot is here to help you remember your grammar rules! Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot loves to talk about her day! She says: 'Je regarde les étoiles avec Nova. Nous jouons dans le jardin. Tu habites près de la forêt. Il mange une pomme.'

1. Identify the infinitive form of the verb 'regarde' used in the passage. (2 marks)

2. Conjugate the verb 'jouer' (to play) for the 'je' (I) and 'nous' (we) forms. (4 marks)

3. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Il mange une pomme.' (3 marks)

4. Why do we remove the '-er' ending from a verb before adding new endings in the present tense? Explain the rule. (4 marks)

5. Fill in the blanks to complete the sentence: 'Elle _____ (habiter) à Londres.' (She lives in London). (2 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph in French (4-5 sentences) describing what you and your friends do after school. Use at least two different -er verbs and the subjects 'je' and 'nous'. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting in a tree, and label the tree in French using a simple phrase like 'un grand arbre'.



Extension challenge: Write one sentence about what you will do tomorrow using the near future structure: 'Demain, je vais...' (Tomorrow, I am going to...). Total: /25
