

French Weather Assessment: Year 4

Learning objective: To be able to identify, write, and use French weather phrases correctly.

Hello! Rosa the parrot is here to help. Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the French words correctly. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot loves flying in all kinds of weather. She looks at the sky to see if she needs her scarf or her sunglasses. Today, Rosa is looking at her weather map to tell her friends what the weather is like across France.

Word bank: Il fait beau - It is lovely weather · Il fait froid - It is cold · Il fait chaud - It is hot · Il pleut - It is raining · Il y a du soleil - It is sunny · Il y a du vent - It is windy · Quel temps fait-il ? - What is the weather like?

1. Rosa asks, 'Quel temps fait-il ?' What does this question mean in English? (2 marks)

2. Write the French phrase for 'It is hot' and 'It is cold'. (2 marks)

3. Look at the picture of a rain cloud in your mind. How do you say 'It is raining' in French? (2 marks)

4. Match the English to the French. Write the correct French phrase next to each English sentence:

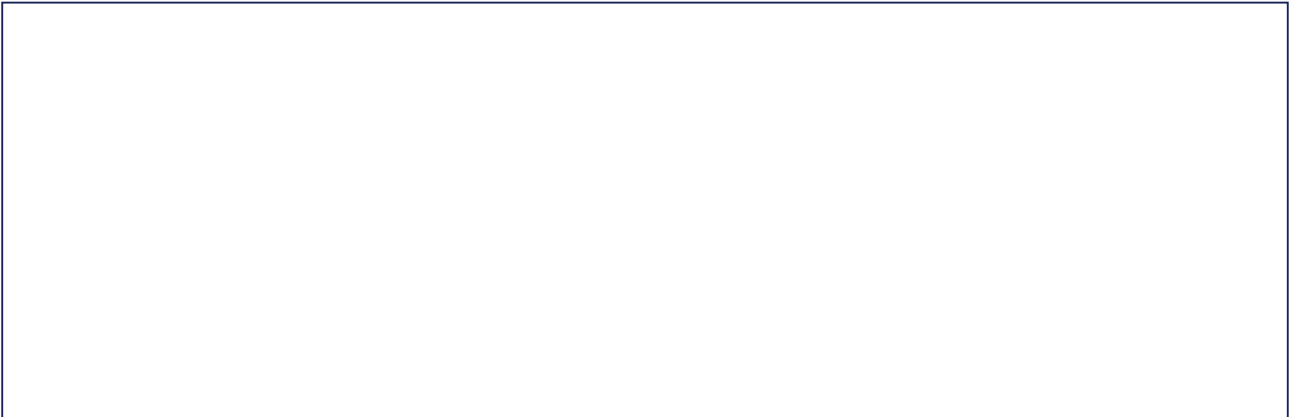
A) It is sunny: _____

5. Rosa is packing her suitcase for a trip. She says: 'Il fait beau.' Explain in English why she is happy about this weather. (4 marks)
