

Rosa's Weather Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To learn and identify French weather vocabulary through drawing.

Follow the steps below to draw your own weather scene. Use the French words to label your picture.

Draw: Create a large, colourful scene on a piece of paper. Divide your paper into four sections. In each section, draw a different type of weather. Use bright colours for the sun, grey for the clouds, and blue for the rain. Make sure your drawings are big enough to write the French labels next to them.



Label words: il fait beau (the weather is nice) · il pleut (it is raining) · il fait du soleil (it is sunny) · il fait froid (it is cold) · le nuage (the cloud)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a bright yellow sun in the top corner. Label it with 'il fait du soleil'.
2. Step 2: Draw two grey shapes in the sky. Label them 'le nuage'.
3. Step 3: Draw small blue lines falling from one cloud to show it is raining. Label this 'il pleut'.
4. Step 4: Draw a small snowman in the corner to show 'il fait froid'.
