

Rosa's Weather Report

Learning objective: To learn and identify French words for the weather.

Read the sentences below. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. You can use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Hello! I am Rosa. I love to travel and learn new words. Today, I am looking at the weather. In France, we say 'Quel temps fait-il?' to ask 'What is the weather like?'. If the sun is out, I say 'Il y a du soleil'. If I need my umbrella, I say 'Il pleut'.

Word bank: Il fait beau - It is nice weather · Il pleut - It is raining · Il fait froid - It is cold · Il fait chaud - It is hot · Il y a du soleil - It is sunny

1. Rosa wants to know the weather. How do you say 'It is sunny' in French? (2 marks)

2. If it is raining, what do you say in French? Start your answer with: 'It is raining is...' (2 marks)

3. Which French phrase means 'It is hot'? (2 marks)

4. Look at the window. What is the weather like today? Write it in French. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself standing outside. If it is sunny, draw a sun. If it is raining, draw a cloud. Label your picture with the correct French weather phrase from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend 'Quel temps fait-il?' and help them answer using the word bank?
