

Rosa the Parrot's Weather Report

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different types of weather.

Hello! I am Rosa. Look at the pictures below. Use the word bank to help you write the French words for the weather. Use the sentence starters to help you.

Word bank: Il fait beau (It is nice) · Il pleut (It is raining) · Il fait froid (It is cold) · Il fait chaud (It is hot) · Il y a du soleil (It is sunny)

1. Look at the sun. Write the French phrase for 'It is sunny'. (1 mark)

2. Look at the rain clouds. Write the French phrase for 'It is raining'. (1 mark)

3. Complete the sentence: Today, it is hot in French is... (1 mark)

4. Match the feeling: If I am wearing a coat, is it 'Il fait froid' or 'Il fait chaud'? (2 marks)

5. Write a full sentence starting with 'Aujourd'hui' (Today) to describe the weather you see outside your window. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a sunny day on the left and a rainy day on the right. Label each picture with the correct French phrase from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Ask a partner: 'Quel temps fait-il?' (What is the weather like?). Write down their answer in your book.
