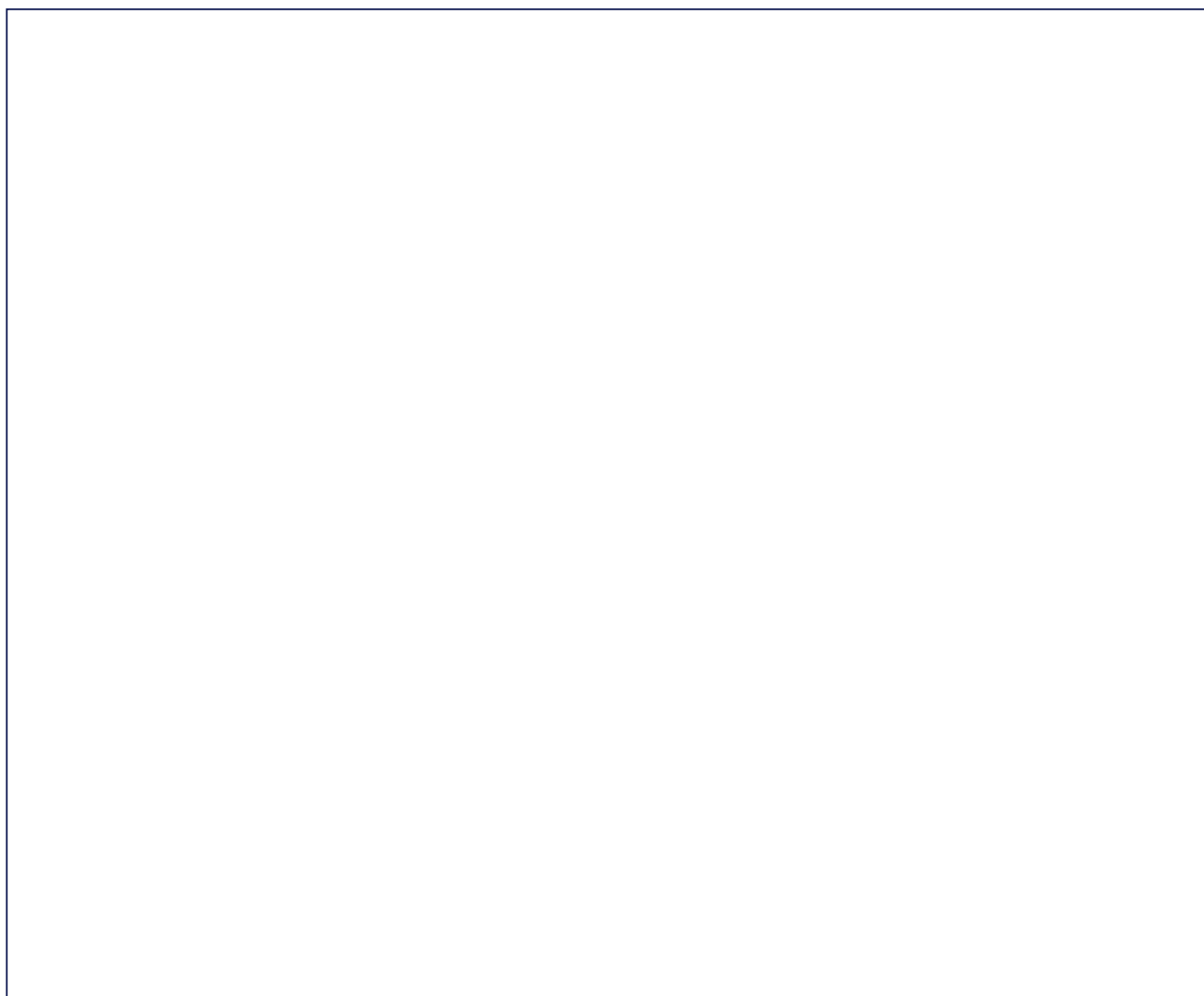


Rosa's Weather Journal: Le Temps

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate common weather conditions in French and use them to describe a scene.

Rosa the parrot wants to keep a weather journal! Follow the drawing prompt below to create a French weather landscape. Use the word bank to label your drawing, ensuring your spelling matches the French terms provided.

Draw: Create a landscape scene that captures four different weather types at once. The style should be clear and colourful, like an educational poster. Ensure there is enough empty space around your drawings to write the French labels clearly using the provided word bank.



Label words: Il fait beau · Il pleut · Il fait froid · Il fait du vent · Il y a des nuages · Il fait chaud

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, bright sun in the top right corner of your page and label it 'Il fait beau'.
2. Step 2: Draw a small grey cloud with raindrops falling near the bottom left and label it 'Il pleut'.
3. Step 3: Draw a tree with leaves blowing sideways to show it is windy and label it 'Il fait du vent'.
4. Step 4: Draw a character wearing a thick scarf and coat in the centre of the scene and label it 'Il fait froid'.
5. Step 5: Write a full French sentence at the bottom of your sheet to describe the weather you would like to

have on your birthday (e.g., 'Aujourd'hui, il fait chaud').
