

Rosa's Weather Wonders: A French Quiz

Learning objective: To recall and apply French vocabulary related to weather conditions at a Year 5 level.

Join Rosa the parrot as she flies across France! Read the questions carefully and choose the correct French weather phrase to complete the task.

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.True, 3.Il pleut, 4.B, 5.False, 6.Il fait froid, 7.A, 8.True, 9.Il fait beau, 10.B. Rosa reminds you: Always use 'Il fait' for temperature and 'Il y a' for weather elements like wind or sun!
