

Rosa's Weather Report: La Météo

Learning objective: To be able to identify, write, and use French vocabulary to describe the weather accurately.

Help Rosa the parrot prepare for her flight across France by identifying the weather patterns in French. Use the word bank to help you complete the tasks below.

Word bank: Il fait beau - It is beautiful/sunny · Il fait chaud - It is hot · Il fait froid - It is cold · Il pleut - It is raining · Il y a du soleil - It is sunny · Il y a du vent - It is windy · Il neige - It is snowing

1. Rosa is flying over Paris and it is a very sunny day. Write the correct French phrase to describe this weather. (1 mark)

2. If Rosa needs to wear a thick scarf because the temperature has dropped, which French phrase should she use to describe the weather? Translate it into English. (2 marks)

3. Match the weather to the activity: If it is 'Il pleut', what should Rosa take with her to stay dry? Write your answer in English. (2 marks)

4. Translate these two sentences into French: 'It is hot' and 'It is windy'. (2 marks)

5. Rosa sees snowflakes falling from the sky. Write the French phrase for this weather. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot flying over a landscape. In one half of the sky, draw 'Il y a du soleil', and in the other half, draw 'Il pleut'. Label both sides with the correct French phrases.



Extension challenge: Write a short weather forecast for three different French cities using the phrases you have learnt today. For example: 'À Paris, il fait beau. À Lyon, il y a du vent...'
