

Finn's Amazing Habitats

Learning objective: To identify and describe different environments and the animals that live in them.

Help Finn the Dolphin explore the world! Look at the words in the bank and match them to the correct places where animals live.

Finn the Dolphin travels across the big blue ocean. He visits hot, sandy places where the sun shines bright. He travels to chilly, icy lands where polar bears play. He also visits deep, green woods full of tall trees. Every place is a special home called a habitat.

Word bank: Desert · Ocean · Forest · Arctic

1. Finn swims in the blue water. Is this place a desert or an ocean? (1 mark)

2. Which habitat is very cold and has lots of ice: the Forest or the Arctic? (1 mark)

3. Name one thing you might find in a Forest habitat. (2 marks)

4. If a place has lots of sand and very little rain, what do we call it? (1 mark)

5. Why do animals need a habitat to live in? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite habitat. Include one animal that lives there and show what the weather is like.



Extension challenge: Talk to a friend about your drawing. Can you tell them one reason why a polar bear would be too hot in the desert?
