- **The Rainforest** is a warm and wet biome where many colourful plants and tall trees grow.
- **The Desert** is a very dry biome where it does not rain very often.
- **The Tundra** is a very cold biome where the ground stays frozen for most of the year.
- **The Grassland** is a wide-open biome that is covered in tall grasses and has few trees.
- **Climate** is the word we use to describe the usual weather in a place over a long time.

Did you know? Did you know? A biome is a large area of the Earth that has its own special climate, plants, and animals. Even though it is one big planet, it is made up of many different 'homes' for nature!
