

Finn's Climate Explorer Sheet

Learning objective: To understand and identify different types of weather and climates in our world.

Help Finn the dolphin explore the world! Look at the different weather scenes and draw what you might see in each place. Use the word bank to help you label your beautiful pictures.

Draw: Divide the paper into four squares. In the top left square, draw a hot desert scene with a bright sun. In the top right square, draw a snowy mountain scene with fluffy white snow. In the bottom left, draw a rainy day with puddles. In the bottom right, draw a windy day with trees blowing in the breeze. Use colourful pencils or crayons.



Label words: Sunny · Snowy · Rainy · Windy · Cloudy · Hot · Cold

Steps:

1. Draw a bright yellow sun in the hot climate box. What do you wear when it is hot?
2. Draw a snowflake in the cold climate box. What clothes keep us warm in the snow?
3. Which weather do you like best? Draw a picture of yourself playing in that weather.
4. Label your drawing of the sun using a word from the word bank.
5. If it is raining, what do we use to stay dry?
