What is the name for the average weather conditions over a long time?	What is the name for the state of the air outside right now?
Climate	Weather
What is the imaginary line around the middle of the Earth called?	What do we call a place that is very hot and gets lots of rain?
The Equator	Tropical
What do we call a place that is very cold and has ice all year?	What is the word for rain, snow, or hail falling from the sky?
Polar	Precipitation
What measures how hot or cold it is?	What do we call a very dry place with little rain?
Temperature	Desert
Finn the dolphin loves warm water. Where is the Earth warmest?	Does climate change quickly or over a very long time?
Near the Equator	Over a very long time
What is the weather like in a tropical zone?	What is the weather like in a polar zone?
Hot and rainy	Very cold and icy
