

Finn's Big Ocean Adventure: Mapping Our World

Learning objective: To identify and name the world's seven continents and five oceans, understanding that the Earth is made up of large land masses and vast areas of water.

Finn the Dolphin has been swimming all around the world! He has sent you a map with some missing labels. Look at the word bank and help Finn label his map. Use a crayon to trace a line from the name in the word bank to the correct space on the map. If it is land, colour it green. If it is water, colour it blue.

Word bank: Africa · Antarctica · Asia · Atlantic Ocean · Australia · Europe · Indian Ocean · North America · Pacific Ocean · South America

1. Finn is swimming in the largest, deepest ocean. Can you name the Pacific Ocean? (1 mark)

2. We live in the United Kingdom. Which continent is the United Kingdom part of? (1 mark)

3. Which continent is covered in ice and is home to penguins? (1 mark)

4. How many oceans are there in total on our planet? (1 mark)

5. If you were a dolphin like Finn, would you prefer to swim in an ocean or walk on a continent? Why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Finn the Dolphin swimming in the middle of the big blue ocean. Can you draw a ship or a whale swimming next to him?



Extension challenge: Ask an adult to help you find a globe or a world map. Can you point to your own country and then find the ocean that is closest to where you live?
