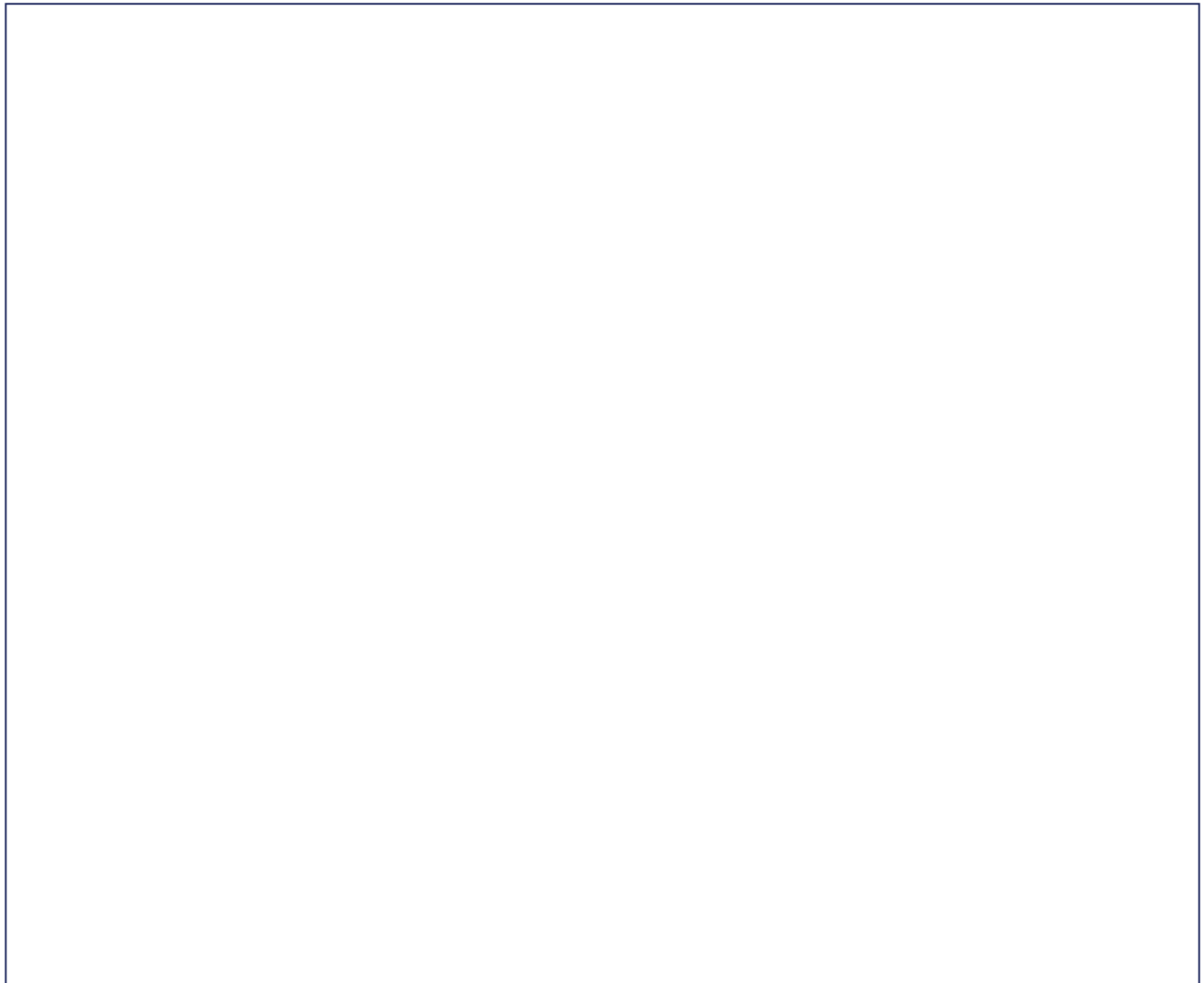


Finn's Map of the World

Learning objective: To identify and label the seven continents and five oceans of the world.

Follow the steps below to complete your world map. Use the word bank to help you label each part correctly. Keep your labels neat.

Draw: Draw a large, simple outline of the world map in the centre of the page. Use a black fineliner for the coastlines. Inside the shapes, leave space to write the names of the continents. Around the land, draw wavy lines to represent the oceans. Use a clear, simple style like a classroom atlas. Make sure each continent has a distinct shape and space for a label.



Label words: Africa · Antarctica · Asia · Australia · Europe · North America · South America · Arctic Ocean · Atlantic Ocean · Indian Ocean · Pacific Ocean · Southern Ocean

Steps:

1. Step 1: Use your blue pencil to shade in the five oceans on your map. Label them using the word bank.
2. Step 2: Use different colours to shade in each of the seven continents. Label them clearly.
3. Step 3: Which is the largest continent on your map? Write its name here: _____
4. Step 4: Draw a small star to show where the Southern Ocean is located. It is near the bottom of the map.
