Learning objective: To identify and name the seven continents and five oceans of the world, understanding their global distribution.

Use these flashcards to test your knowledge of world geography. Finn the Dolphin has been mapping the globe and wants to see if you can keep up with his travels! Read the question on the front, think of your answer, then flip to reveal the fact.

What is the name of the largest continent in the world?	Which ocean is located between the Americas and Europe?
Asia	The Atlantic Ocean
Name the smallest continent, which is also a country.	Which ocean is found around the North Pole?
Australia	The Arctic Ocean
What is a continent?	Which ocean touches the coast of Africa, India, and Australia?
A large, continuous mass of land separated by expanses of water.	The Indian Ocean
Which continent is known for being the coldest and containing the South Pole?	Which is the largest and deepest ocean on Earth?
Antarctica	The Pacific Ocean
Name the continent that lies entirely to the south of the Equator and is famous for the Amazon Rainforest.	Which ocean surrounds the continent of Antarctica?
South America	The Southern Ocean
How many continents are there on Earth?	Which two continents are connected by the Isthmus of Panama?
Seven (Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Europe, North America, Oceania/Australia, and South America)	North America and South America
