

Finn's Treasure Map Adventure

Learning objective: To develop an understanding of how to use symbols and simple maps to represent features of the local environment.

Help Finn the dolphin explore the beach! Use the word bank to label the different parts of the map you draw. Remember to include a 'key' to show what your symbols mean.

Draw: Create a bird's-eye view map of a beach. Use bright, clear colours. Include a blue area for the sea, a yellow or beige area for the sand, and a designated 'X' for the location of the hidden treasure. The style should be simple, using shapes to represent objects (e.g., small circles for rocks, a rectangle for the chest).



Label words: sand · sea · rock pool · path · treasure chest

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a wavy line to show where the sea meets the sand.
2. Step 2: Draw a small circle in the sand to be a rock pool.
3. Step 3: Draw a winding path leading from the sea to the treasure chest.
4. Label your rock pool using a word from the word bank.
5. Draw one thing you might find on a beach, like a shell or a piece of seaweed, near your treasure chest.
