Learning objective: To identify and describe the key features of the Arctic and the Antarctic regions.

Read the front of the card. Try to guess the answer. Then, look at the back of the card to check if you are right. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

Where is the Arctic located?

At the very top of the world, in the Northern Hemisphere.

Where is the Antarctic located?

At the very bottom of the world, in the Southern Hemisphere.

What is the North Pole?

The most northern point on Earth.

What is the South Pole?

The most southern point on Earth.

What is an iceberg?

A large piece of ice that has broken off a glacier and is floating in the sea.

What is a glacier?

A giant, slow-moving river of ice found on land.

What is the climate like in the Polar regions?

Very cold, windy, and snowy all year round.

True or False: Polar regions are near the Equator.

False. They are as far away from the Equator as possible.

Does the Arctic have land under the ice?

No, the Arctic is mostly frozen ocean.

Does the Antarctic have land under the ice?

Yes, the Antarctic is a giant continent covered in thick ice.

Which animal lives in the Arctic?

The polar bear.

Which animal lives in the Antarctic?

The penguin.
