- An iceberg is a large piece of ice that has broken off a glacier and floats in the sea.
- Animals in the polar regions have thick fur or blubber to stay warm in the freezing temperatures.

Did you know? Did you know? The Arctic is mostly frozen ocean surrounded by land, but the Antarctic is a giant continent covered in very thick ice! Polar bears only live in the Arctic, while penguins live in the Antarctic.
