

Finn's River Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and understand the features of a river as part of the geography curriculum.

Colour in the picture of the river. Use blue for the water and green for the grass on the riverbanks. Talk to an adult about how the water moves.

Colour this: A friendly, simple landscape showing a winding river flowing from the top of a hill down to the bottom of the page. Include large, clear outlines of: a gentle hill (the source) at the top, a wide river path with ripples, grassy riverbanks on both sides, a few simple trees, and Finn the dolphin waving from the bottom corner where the river widens. Use thick, bold black lines for easy colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the river in your picture.
2. Label the grassy bank in your picture.
