- The source is the very beginning of a river, usually found high up in the mountains or hills.
- A river channel is the path that the water follows as it travels across the land.
- A meander is a winding, snake-like curve that the river makes as it moves along.
- The riverbank is the land found on either side of the river water.
- The mouth is the end of the river where it flows into the sea or a large lake.

Did you know? Did you know? The longest river in the United Kingdom is the River Severn. It flows for about 220 miles before it reaches the sea!
