

Finn's Market Map: My Trading Adventure

Learning objective: To understand that trade involves exchanging goods for money and that items come from different places.

Help Finn the dolphin explore how shops get their items. Talk to a grown-up about where your favourite fruit or toy might have come from. Use the boxes below to plan your own little shop. Draw what you are selling, how much it costs in pounds (£), and where you found it.

Word bank: trade · money · shop · coins · travel · exchange · price · pounds

1. My Shop Item: What are you selling in your shop today? Draw it and write its name.

2. The Price: How much does your item cost? Write the amount in pounds (£).

3. Where did it come from? Did your item travel on a boat, a plane, or a lorry to get to the shop?

4. Trading Talk: If a friend wants to buy your item, what money will they give you?

5. Finn's Map: Draw a line from your shop to where you think your item was made.

Extension challenge: Ask a grown-up to show you a label on a piece of clothing or food. Find the name of the country it came from and try to find that country on a globe or map with Finn!
