

Finn's UK Adventure: Sorting the Regions

Learning objective: To identify and name the four countries that make up the United Kingdom, and recognise simple features of their landscapes.

Finn the dolphin has been swimming all around the coast of the United Kingdom. He has found some special things in each place! Look at the list of items below and draw a line to match each one to the correct UK country where Finn found it. If you aren't sure, think about what each place is famous for!
