

Finn's Great UK Adventure

Learning objective: To identify that the United Kingdom is made up of different countries and to recognise basic features of our local area and the wider UK.

Help Finn the dolphin map out the United Kingdom! Look at the map of the four countries and answer the questions below to show what you have learned.

Finn the dolphin is swimming all around the coast of our home, the United Kingdom! He can see beautiful green hills in Scotland, busy cities in England, tall mountains in Wales, and sparkling lakes in Northern Ireland. Finn uses his map to make sure he knows exactly where he is swimming.

1. Finn has visited four countries in the United Kingdom. Can you name two of them? (2 marks)

2. Which country do you live in? You can draw a circle around it on your classroom map. (1 mark)

3. Finn sees lots of water around the UK. Is the UK an island or a forest? (1 mark)

4. If you were going to visit a friend in a different part of the UK, would you travel by boat, bus, or train? Why? (2 marks)

5. Look at the map of the UK. Which country is at the very top of the map? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a place in the United Kingdom that you would like to visit. Maybe you will draw a sandy beach, a big city with tall buildings, or a quiet green park.



Extension challenge: Talk to your grown-up about a trip you have taken. Did you travel to a different town or city? Was it near the sea or in the countryside?
