1. Name one of the four countries that make up the United Kingdom. What is its capital city? (2 marks)

2. Describe one thing you might see in this region, such as mountains, beaches, or big cities. (2 marks)

3. Finn swims in the sea around the UK. Which sea or ocean is near the region you chose? (2 marks)

4. Why is it important to know about different regions in the United Kingdom? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Draw a small map of the region you chose. Can you label the capital city and draw one special landmark found there?
