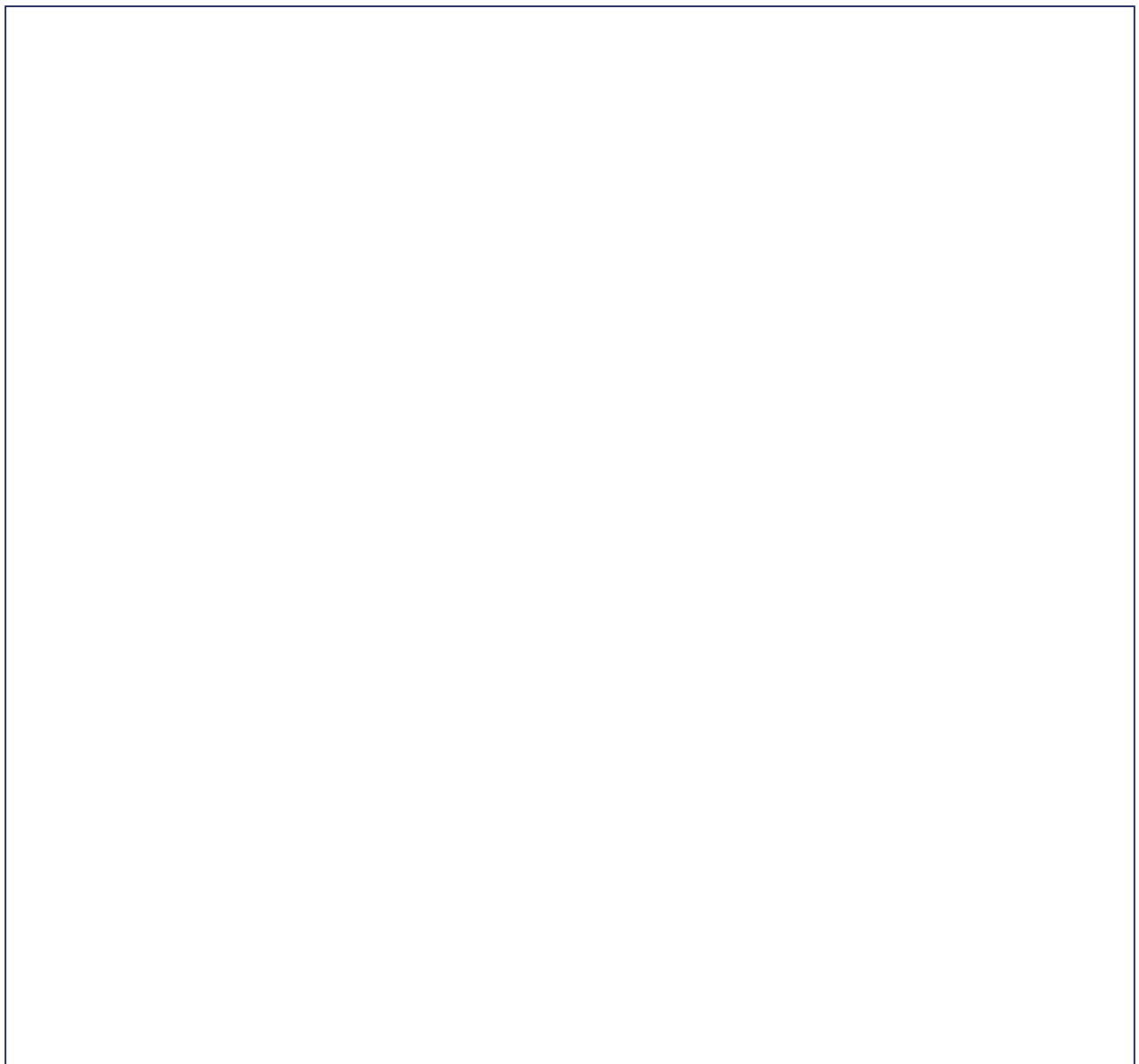


Finn's Volcano Adventure

Learning objective: To identify the features of a volcano and understand that they are part of our Earth's landscape.

Welcome to the island! Join Finn the dolphin as he visits a tropical island. Colour in the volcano, the flowing lava, and the beautiful palm trees. Use your brightest reds and oranges for the lava!

Colour this: A friendly, clear line-art scene for children to colour. In the centre, a large, gentle-sloping mountain (volcano) with a jagged crater at the peak. Thick, wavy lines represent lava flowing down the side of the mountain. At the base of the volcano, include a sandy beach with two simple palm trees. In the corner, draw Finn the dolphin peeking out of the blue ocean waves, wearing a small explorer's hat. Use bold, thick outlines suitable for young children.



Steps:

1. Label the top part of the volcano where the lava comes out (the crater).
2. Label the hot, orange liquid flowing down the side of the volcano.
