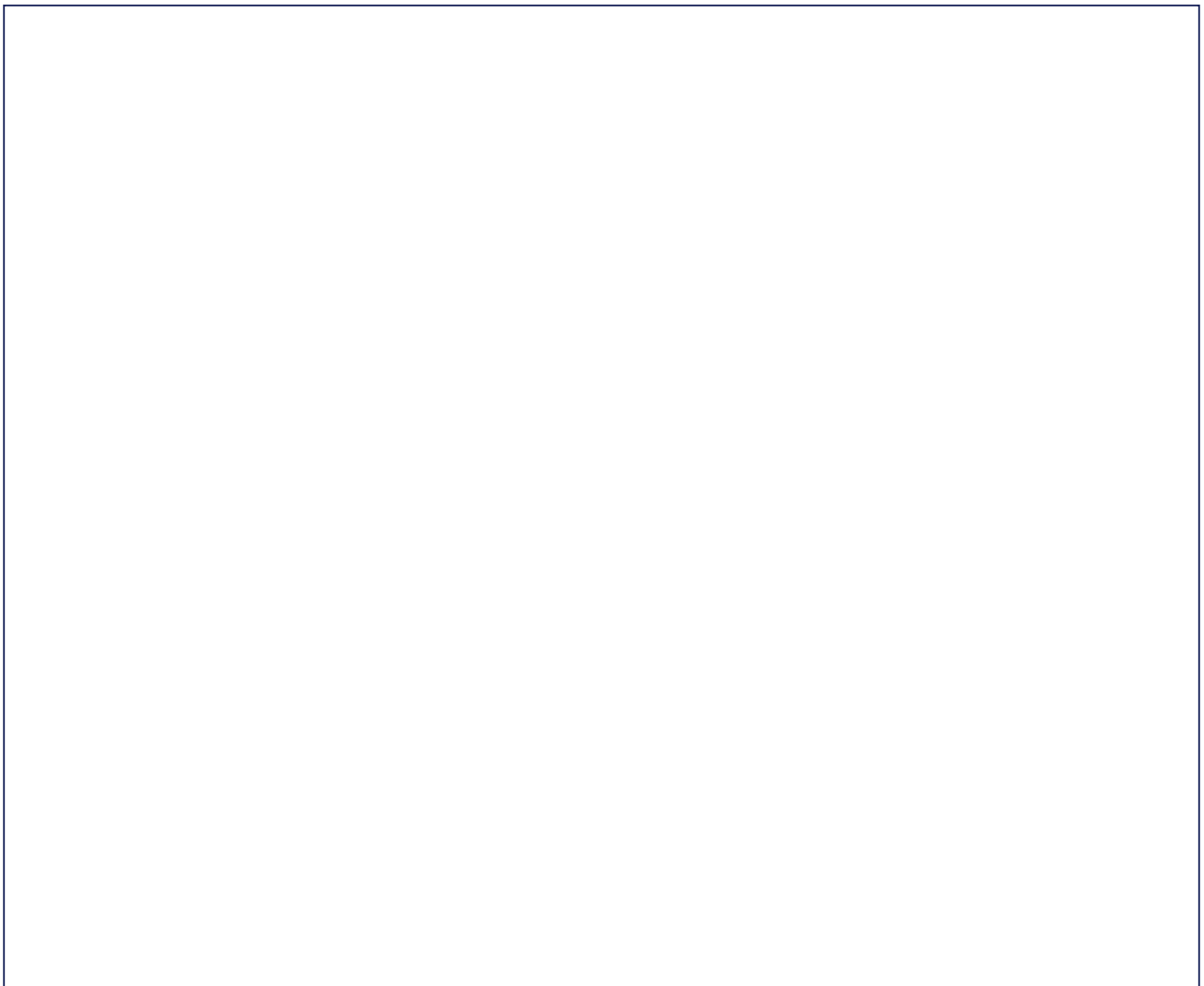


Finn's Weather Explorer Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate different types of weather and understand the difference between weather and climate.

Follow the steps below to create your weather map. Use your pencils to draw the symbols clearly. Read the labels in the word bank and add them to your drawing where they fit best.

Draw: Create a landscape scene on your paper. In the left sky, draw a bright yellow sun. In the centre sky, draw fluffy grey clouds with blue raindrops. On the ground, draw a tree that looks like it is blowing in the wind. Use bright colours for the sunshine and soft greys for the clouds.



Label words: Rain · Sunshine · Windy · Cloudy · Temperature

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large sun in the top corner of your page to show hot weather. Write the word 'Sunshine' next to it.
2. Step 2: Draw some grey clouds in the middle of your page. Add some raindrops falling from them. Label this 'Rain'.
3. Step 3: Draw a tree with its branches leaning to one side. This shows it is 'Windy'. Label your drawing.
4. Step 4: Finn the dolphin wants to know the temperature. Draw a small thermometer near your sun and

write 'Temperature' next to it.
