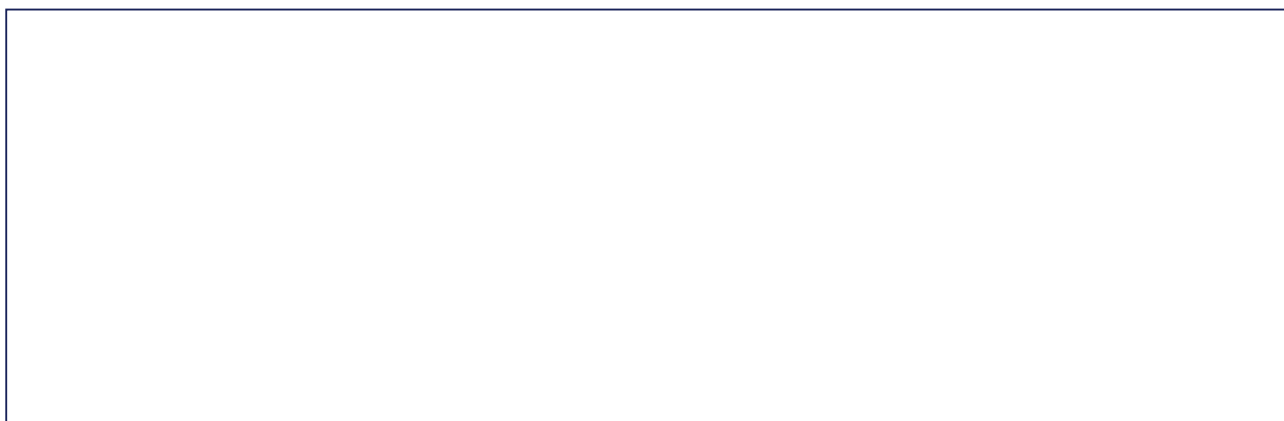
7. 7. What falls from the sky when it is wet outside? (1 word) (1 mark)
