Word bank: Nile · farming · pharaoh · pyramids · silt

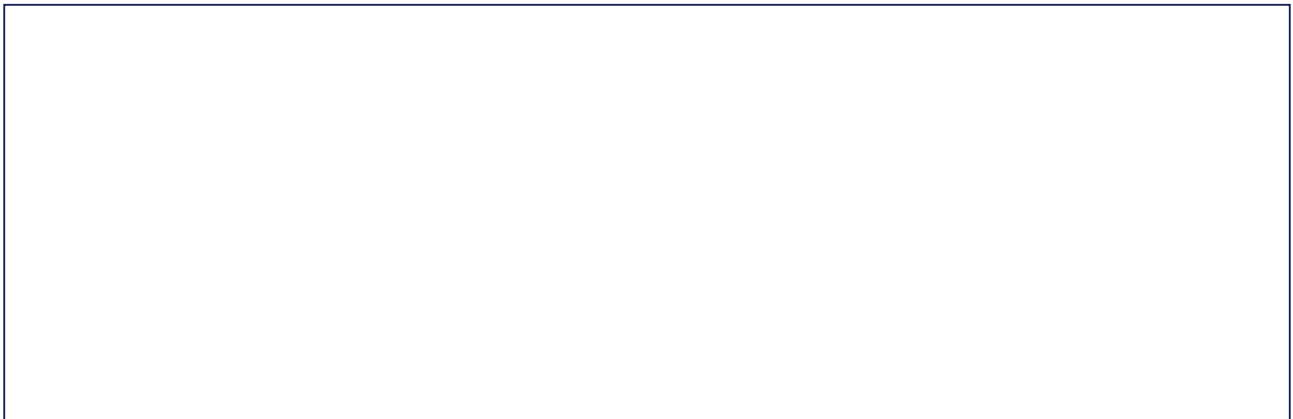
1. The people of Ancient Egypt lived near a very important river. What is the name of this river? (1 mark)
