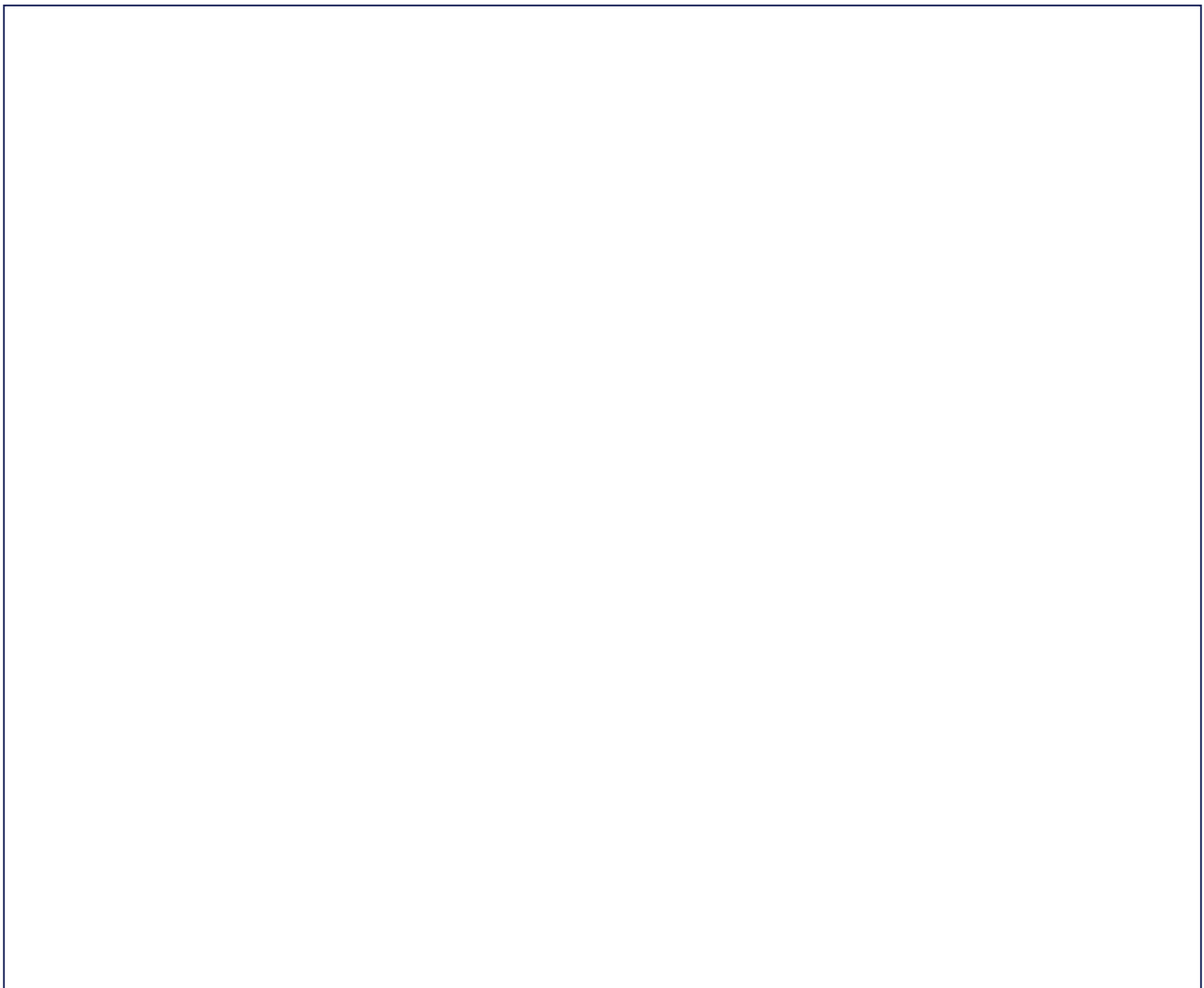


Ellie's History Heroes: Celebrating Special People

Learning objective: To recognise that people from the past have made important contributions to our world and to express this through drawing.

Follow the steps below to draw a picture of a special person who helped change the world. Use your imagination to show them doing something kind or brave!

Draw: Draw a large, clear portrait of a person in the centre of the page. Use bright colours to show their personality. In the background, draw symbols of what they achieved, such as a school building if they helped children learn, or a garden if they helped nature. Keep the style simple and friendly with bold outlines.



Label words: Hero · Kind · Brave · Change · Helpful · History

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a person who you think is a hero. Give them a big smile!
2. Step 2: Draw something they did to help others, like planting a tree or holding a sign for peace.
3. Step 3: Label your hero using one word from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a sunshine in the corner to show how they made the world a brighter place.
5. Step 5: Tell your teacher or a friend one reason why your hero is special.
