Word bank: fairness · equal · respect · justice · rights

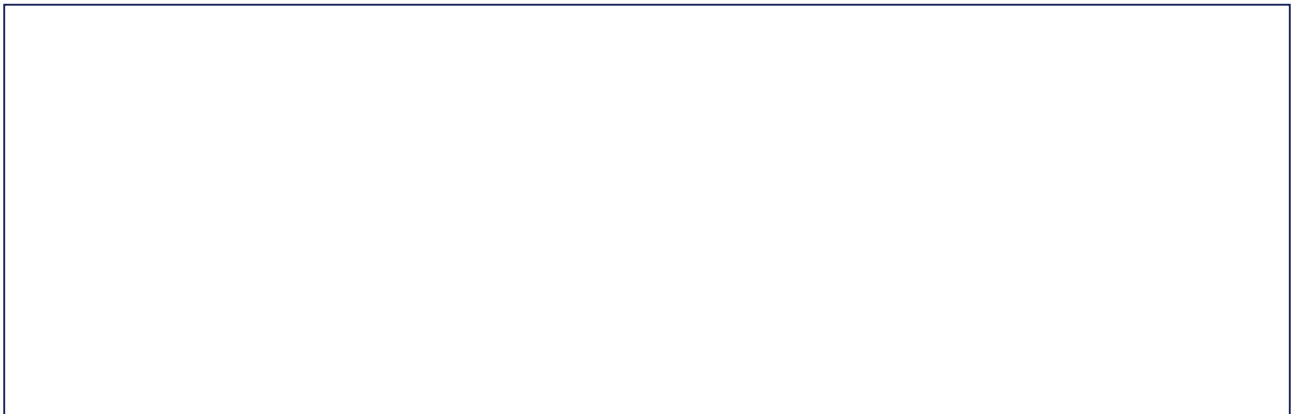
1. Ellie the elephant believes everyone should be treated with kindness. What is one way you can show respect to a friend in your class? (2 marks)
