

Florence Nightingale: The Lady with the Lamp

Learning objective: To understand the role of Florence Nightingale in history and identify key items associated with her work in hospitals.

Look at the word bank and think about how Florence helped people in the hospital. Use the drawing space below to show Florence Nightingale caring for others. Make sure to include her famous lamp!

Draw: Draw a large, bright hospital scene. In the centre, draw Florence Nightingale wearing her nurse's uniform (a long dress and an apron). In her hand, draw a glowing lantern or lamp. Beside her, draw a patient lying in a comfortable bed. Use bright, cheerful colours to show that she is bringing care and kindness to the hospital room.



Label words: Lamp · Hospital · Florence · Nurse · Medicine · Care

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big, warm hospital room with a bed inside.
2. Step 2: Draw Florence Nightingale standing in the room. What is she holding to help her see in the dark?
3. Step 3: Draw a happy patient resting in the bed.
4. Step 4: Label the lamp you drew using a word from the word bank.
5. Step 5: Why did Florence use a lamp? Talk to your teacher or a friend about your answer.
