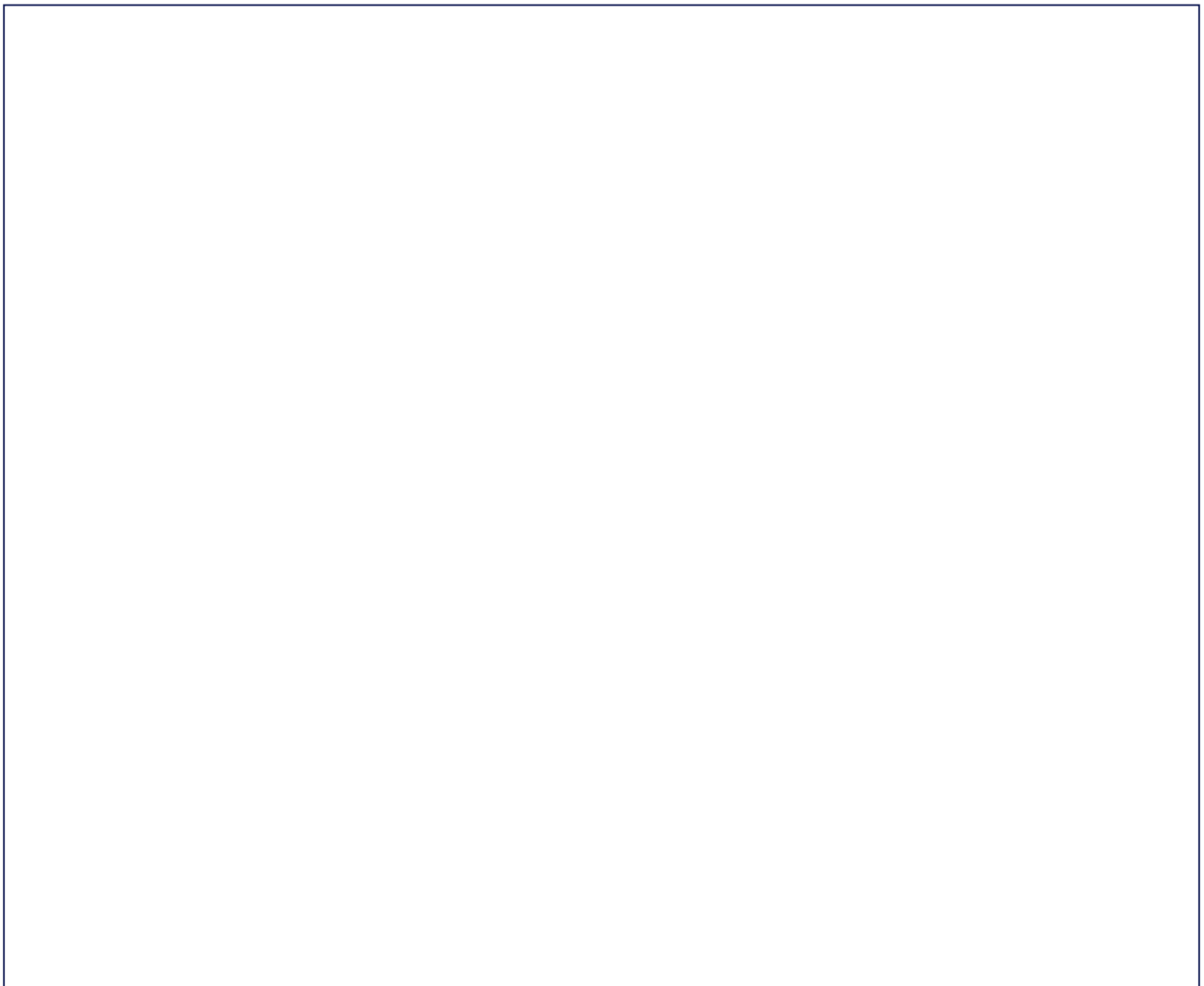


My Local History Map

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate important historical features in our local area.

Ellie the elephant is helping us explore history! Look at your town or village. Think about buildings or places that have been there for a long time. Use the space below to draw your local area.

Draw: Draw a street scene from your local area. Use a pencil to sketch the outlines first. Include one old building, such as a church or a stone cottage. Add details like a cobblestone path or a bridge. Use bright colours for the modern items and soft colours for the old historical parts to show how time has passed.



Label words: church · old shop · bridge · statue · park · cottage · cobbles

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a building or a place that is very old in your town.
2. Step 2: Label one thing in your drawing using a word from the word bank.
3. Step 3: Draw a person from the past walking near your building.
4. Step 4: Draw one way your area has changed (e.g., a modern car or a new road).
