

Ellie's Remembrance Day Garden

Learning objective: To understand the significance of Remembrance Day as a time to remember those who helped us and to recognise the poppy as a symbol of peace.

Ellie the Elephant is planting a memorial garden. Look at the items below. Draw a line to match each item to its meaning. Some items represent our promise to remember, and others represent the peace we hope for in the world.

Word bank: Poppy · Peace · Remembrance · Soldier · Respect

1. Match the Poppy to its meaning: Does it mean 'A flower to show we remember' or 'A flower for a birthday party'? (2 marks)

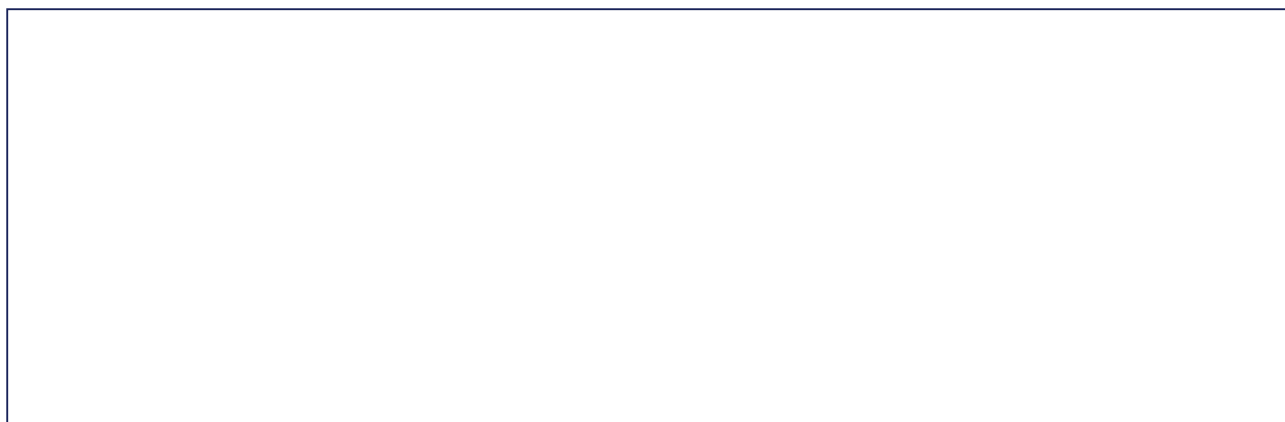
2. Why do we have a special day in November to remember people who helped us? (2 marks)

3. When we see a poppy, should we be loud and silly, or quiet and thoughtful? (2 marks)

4. If you bought a poppy for £1, how many £1 coins would you need to buy two poppies? (2 marks)

5. Can you name one person in your life who helps keep you safe, like the people we remember on this day? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a beautiful red poppy flower in the centre of Ellie's garden. Add some green leaves and a bright yellow sun in the sky to show our hope for peace.



Extension challenge: With an adult, find out why the poppy is red. Talk about how wearing a poppy shows we are thinking of people who were brave.
