Key Vocabulary

Read the words and their meanings below to help you learn about Remembrance Day. You can use these words in your writing or class discussions. Categorise them into 'The Past', 'Remembering', and 'Peace'.

Conflict A serious disagreement or a war between...	Soldier A person who serves in an army.	Remembrance The act of remembering someone or something.
Poppy A bright red flower often worn to show respect for those who served in the armed forces.	Armistice An agreement to stop fighting; it ends a war.	Peace A time when there is no war or fighting.
Sacrifice Giving up something very important for a greater purpose.	Tribute Something said or done to show respect for someone.	Wreath A circle made of flowers and leaves, often used as a symbol of remembrance.
Silence A quiet time when we think about the people who served.	History The study of things that happened in the past.	Memorial A structure or statue built to help people remember someone.
Service A special event held to remember those who served.	Veteran A person who has served in the armed forces.	Honour To show great respect for someone.
