Learning objective: To show what you know about life in the Stone Age.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Ellie the elephant is studying history. She has travelled back in time to the Stone Age. She wants to see how people lived a long time ago. Some people moved around to find food. Later, people started to build homes and farm the land.

1. Name one tool that people used in the Stone Age. (2 marks)

2. What do we call people who travel to find food instead of staying in one place? (2 marks)

3. How was life different in the Neolithic time compared to the Palaeolithic time? (4 marks)

4. Why was fire important for Stone Age people? Give two reasons. (4 marks)

5. Imagine you live in the Stone Age. Describe your daily life. What do you eat? Where do you sleep? What work do you do? (Use at least 3 words from the word bank). (13 marks)
