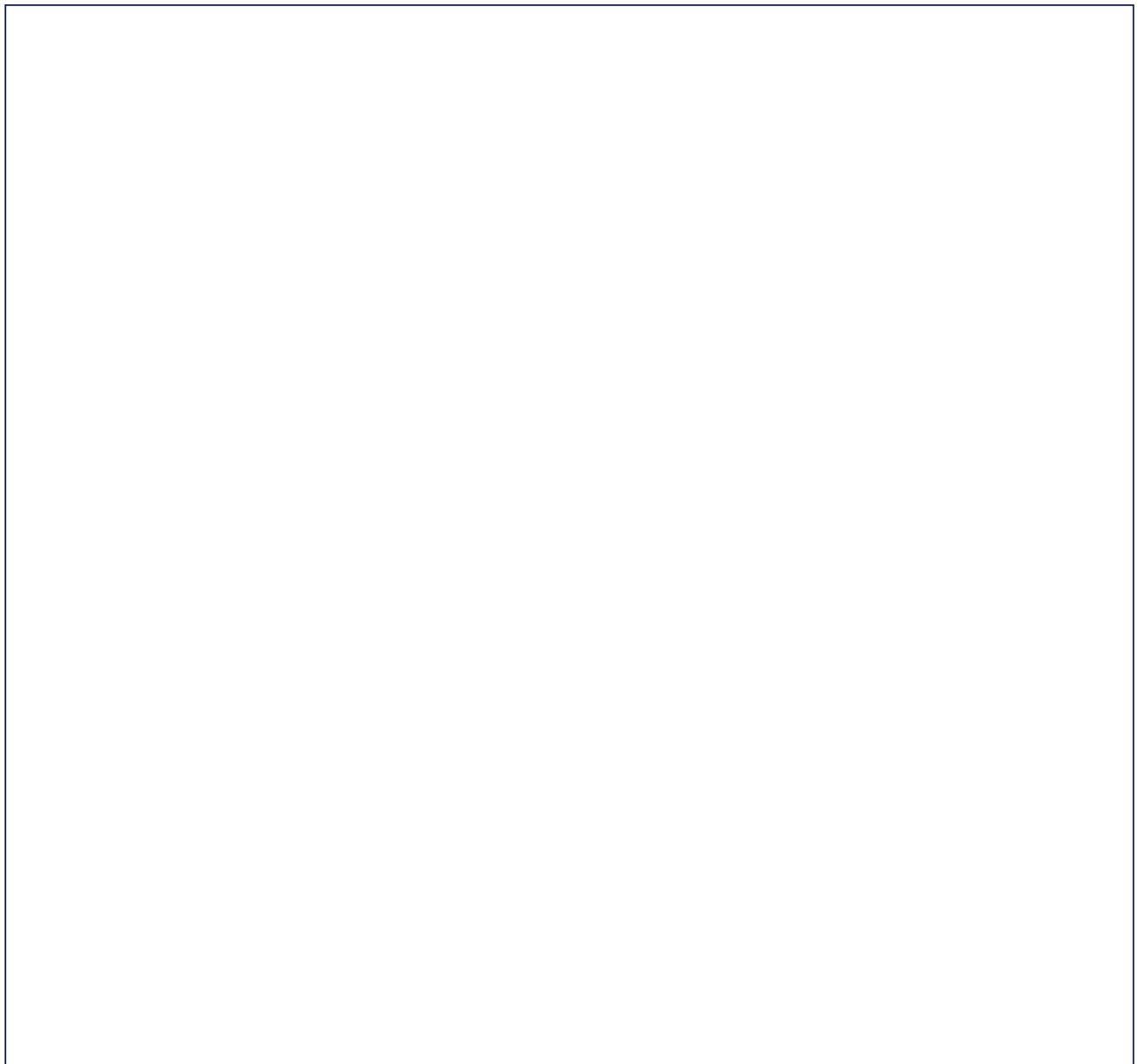


Max the Monkey's Market Maths

Learning objective: To solve one-step addition problems using concrete objects and pictorial representations.

Help Max the Monkey count his fruit at the market! Solve the addition sums in the boxes, then colour in the fruit to match your answers.

Colour this: In the centre of the page, draw Max the Monkey wearing a small apron, standing behind a wooden market stall. On the stall, draw 4 red apples and 3 green apples in one basket, and 5 yellow bananas and 2 extra bananas in another basket. Below each fruit group, draw a small empty box for the child to write the sum. Add a price tag next to the apples that says '£1' and a tag next to the bananas that says '£2'. Use thick, clear black outlines for the fruit and Max to make colouring easier for Year 1 children.



Steps:

1. Max has 4 red apples and 3 green apples. How many apples does he have in total? Write your answer here:
2. Max buys 5 yellow bananas and 2 more bananas. How many bananas does he have altogether? Write

your answer here:
