

Max's Angle Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and draw acute, obtuse, and right angles.

Max the monkey is exploring the jungle. Help him draw the angles he sees in the trees and leaves. Use a ruler to make your lines straight.

Draw: Draw a sunny jungle scene featuring a large tree with a thick branch. Include a large green leaf hanging from the branch. The style should be clear, bold, and colourful like a hand-drawn illustration in a sketchbook. Leave plenty of white space around the tree for the student to draw their angles.



Label words: Acute angle · Right angle · Obtuse angle · Vertex

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a small 'V' shape on the tree branch to make an acute angle. Label it 'Acute'.
2. Step 2: Draw a square corner on a leaf to make a right angle. Label it 'Right angle'.
3. Step 3: Draw a wide 'V' shape that is bigger than a right angle to make an obtuse angle. Label it 'Obtuse'.
4. Step 4: Draw a small dot where the two lines of your right angle meet. Label this point the 'Vertex'.
