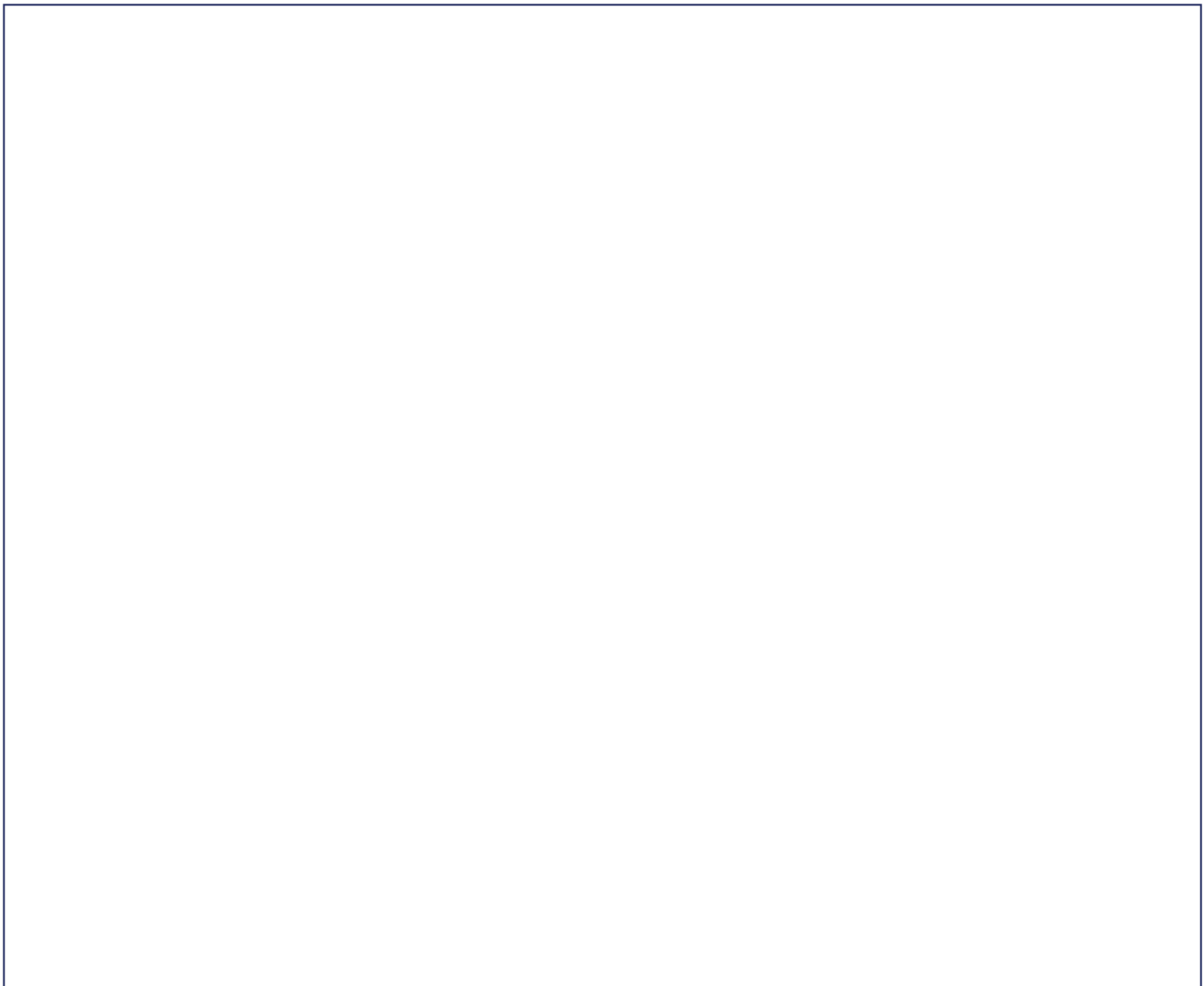


Max's Christmas Market Maths

Learning objective: To solve simple problems involving money and practice drawing shapes in a festive scene.

Help Max the monkey organise the Christmas market stall. Use your ruler to draw the items and answer the maths questions below. Use the word bank to label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a small wooden market stall. On the stall, draw 2 round baubles and 1 star. Draw a piece of tinsel draped across the front of the stall. Add a small label next to the baubles that says '£2'. Use a ruler for straight lines on the stall roof.



Label words: bauble · tinsel · star · price tag · coin

Steps:

1. Max sells 2 baubles for £2 each. How much do they cost in total? Show your working.
2. Draw a star on your stall. If the star costs £4 and a pack of tinsel costs £3, what is the total cost?
3. If you have a £10 note, how much change would you get back from £7?
